Format changes On 9 December 2016, UEFA confirmed the reforming plan for the UEFA Champions League for the 2018-2021 cycle, which was announced on 26 August 2016.[10][11] As per the new regulations, the previous season's UEFA Europa League winners will qualify automatically for the UEFA Champions League group stage (previously they would qualify for the play-off round, but would be promoted to the group stage and been made in all three seasons since it was established from 2015-16). For the draw, the teams were seeded into four pots based on the following principles (introduced starting this season):[13] Pot 1 contained the Champions League and Europa League title holders, and the champions of the top six associations based on their 2017 UEFA country coefficients. If either or both title holders were one of the champions of the next highest ranked association(s) are also seeded into Pot 1. Pot 2, 3 and 4 contained the remaining teams, seeded based on their 2018 UEFA club coefficients.[20] In each group, teams played against each other home-and-away in a round-robin format. The group winners and runners-up advanced to the round of 16, while the third-placed teams entered the 2018-19 UEFA Europa League round of 32. The matchdays were 18-19 September, 2-3 October, 6-7 November, 27-28 November, and 11-12 December 2018.
